1. THE BRUCE LEE AND LEGENDS OF MARTIAL ARTS HALL OF HONOR Background: Bruce Lee's daughter, Shannon, attended the 2002 Arnold Battle of Columbus and accepted The first Hall of Honor Induction Award on behalf of her father, the great Bruce Lee

Bruce Lee promoted the modern concept of martial arts to the world through his many movie roles. He was born on November 27, 1940, in Hong Kong, was a graduate of Washington State University, and starred in many television and film productions including *The Green Hornet* and *Enter the Dragon*. He was an ardent student of Wing Chun Kung Fu and developed and successfully spread his own style, Jeet Kune Do. Bruce Lee passed away in 1973 at the age of 33. He left behind a legacy to be admired and honored.

With his superb talent in martial arts and in action movies, Bruce Lee was able to revolutionize Asian culture, perceptions of the martial arts, and perceptions of Asian people in the western hemisphere forever. He is one of the only movie stars who became more famous after his death. His legacy will never die.

2. THE BRUCE LEE AND LEGENDS OF MARTIAL ARTS HALL OF HONOR

The Bruce Lee and Legends of Martial Arts Hall of Honor is designed to honor pioneers,

grandmasters, masters, instructors, and all other martial arts leaders and supporters who have a proven record of pioneering, developing, and promoting the various oriental martial arts such as Taekwondo, Karate, Kungfu, Wu Shu, Tai Chi, Hapkido, Aikido, Judo, Gumdo/Kendo, Jiu Jitsu/Grappling, Silat, Sambo/Sombo, Muay Thai, Kimoodo Healing arts and other Martial Arts to their region, state, nation, and the world from the 1940s to the present day.

The Bruce Lee and Legends of Martial Arts Hall of Honor Induction does <u>not only</u> recognize first generation leaders but also subsequent generation martial arts leaders who by their own achievement have carried on the spirit of martial arts taught by their first-generation masters to build a lasting legacy and honorable lineage for the coming generations.

3. THE BATTLE OF COLUMBUS HALL OF HONOR:

The Battle of Columbus was founded in 1976 by Late SGM Joon P. Choi with the idea of promoting true diversity in the martial arts community. The Arnold Battle of Columbus offered various martial arts disciplines, and their students, the opportunity to explore their skills and to develop a family-like atmosphere among different martial arts styles.

In 2001, the Battle of Columbus joined with the Arnold Sports Festival as partners and grew to over 4,000 athletes and over 10,000 spectators.

In 2015, in conjunction with The Bruce Lee and Legends of Martial Arts Hall of Honor Induction, SGM Choi began the tradition to honor masters, competitors, coaches, promoters, and volunteers who have dedicated more than 10 years of service to develop the Arnold Battle of Columbus into a unique martial arts championship.

4. HALL OF HONOR - NOMINATION and APPLICATION PROCESS NOMINATIONS

- 2023 HOH NOMINATIONS are open from September 15, 2022, until January 15, 2023.
- Nomination forms and all required information must be submitted to the Hall of Honor Selection Committee **no later than January 15, 2023**.
- Nomination forms must be completed in full and all required supporting documents/data provided before the Committed will act on the nomination.
- Only nominations by 4th dan or higher recognized by qualified organizations will be considered.
- Nominees will be notified if their nomination has been approved and will be asked to submit an Application for Induction.

APPLICATIONS

- Applications for Induction and all required information must be submitted to the Hall of Honor Selection Committee no later than February 1, 2023.
- Application forms must be completed in full and all required supporting documents/data provided before the Committee will act on the Application.
- Honorees will be notified of their acceptance and are invited to purchase the Inductee Dinner Package.
- All Honorees or award recipients must be present at the ceremony to receive their awards.

6. Hall of Honor Induction Standards, Qualifications and Categories

General Criteria

Induction recognizes a lifetime of contribution to the advancement of martial arts and the development of human character through martial arts training; leadership within and a positive influence on the martial arts and other communities; and exemplary personal conduct in accordance with the values of martial arts and its long tradition of loyalty and high ethical standards. Recognition is open to a broad number of inductees to recognize those individuals who have made lifelong contributions to the martial arts from the 1940s to the present.

Nominees are required to meet at least the following criteria

- Distinct martial arts philosophy and has continuously upheld high ethical standards
- Continuously served as positive role model for students by providing an example of positive martial arts behavior and philosophy in everyday life
- Has continuously trained, taught, and applied martial arts principles in everyday life
- Best demonstrates responsibility, integrity, and excellence in life in general
- Has earned outstanding achievements and inspired other human beings
- Is dedicated to promoting the advancement of martial arts for human development

Bruce Lee & Legends Hall of Honor Categories

1. Pioneer

- a. Training began before year 1960 Minimum Age 65
- b. 9th Dan + more than 47 years of training and more than 40 years of teaching
- c. Pioneering martial arts and its culture exceptional service in their respective countries

2. Legacy

- a. First Generation students from Pioneers
- b. Carried on the legacy and spirit of their teachers and seniors and taught and expanded awareness of martial arts culture in the proper way

3. Grandmaster

- a. Training began before 1975 Minimum age 50
- b. 8th Dan and higher more than 35 years of training and more than 25 years of teaching
- c. Exceptional service in the martial arts community for more than 25 years and service as an instructor or officer in a recognized martial arts organization

4. Lifetime Achievement

- a. Training began before year 1975 Minimum age 50
- b. 8th Dan and higher more than 35 years of training and more than 25 years of teaching
- c. Exceptional service in the martial arts community for more than 25 years and service as an instructor or officer in a recognized martial arts organization
- d. Accomplishments, accolades, and achievements throughout a martial arts career far exceed the customary expectation of martial artists of similar age and rank

5. Leadership

- a. Training began before year 1975 Minimum age 50
- b. 8th Dan and higher more than 35 years of training and more than 25 years of teaching
- c. Exceptional service in the martial arts community for more than 25 years and service as an

- instructor or officer in a recognized martial arts organization
- d. Extraordinary contributions to local, regional, national, or global martial arts communities

6. Literary Achievement

- a. Active continuously for more than 20 years at time of nomination
- b. Martial Arts rank is not required, however, martial arts rank will take precedence in selection
- c. Outstanding merit and achievement in one or more of the fields of educational and innovative training information, history, philosophy, or the raising of public awareness of martial arts, particularly regarding the development of character

7. Ambassador

- a. Martial Arts rank is not required, however, martial arts rank will take precedence in selection
- b. The Ambassador Award is presented to individuals who embody the ambassadorial spirit of martial arts and have made selfless contributions. It honors the leadership and exceptional devotion to martial arts that may not be the recipient's primary athletic focus.
- c. The nominee does not have to have been a martial arts practitioner to be considered
- d. Nominees must at least meet the following criteria:
 - i. In good standing with the martial arts community and has positively represented martial arts
 - ii. Demonstrated exceptional abilities in working with different martial arts organizations and disciplines effectively
 - iii. Made noteworthy contributions toward the advancement of and in support of martial
 - iv. Recognized and respected as a role model in his/her profession and community
 - v. Exceptional and excellent leadership qualities
 - vi. Long-standing membership and/or participation in national or international organizations that further the promotion of martial arts and have a distinct martial arts philosophy
 - vii. Demonstrates continuous support for the work of major organizations promoting the spread of martial arts spirit and culture

8. Master

- a. Minimum age of 25
- b. 5th-7th Dan more than 20 continuous years of training and more than 10 continuous years of teaching at time of nomination
- c. Exceptional service in the martial arts community for more than 10 years
- d. Service as an instructor or officer in a recognized martial arts organization

9. Instructor

- a. Minimum age of 25
- b. More than 15 years of continuous training at time of nomination
- c. 3rd 4th Dan, more than 10 years of continuous teaching at time of nomination.
- d. Exceptional service in the martial arts community
- e. Service as an instructor or officer in a recognizable martial arts organization

10. Competitor (Male & Female)

- a. Competed continuously for 10 years or more at time of nomination and won more than 10 total 1st place finishes in Poomsae (Forms/Kata), Sparring, Weapons, Breaking, Demo, Etc., in the listed disciplines in major championships with history and general recognition.
- b. 3rd Dan or higher.

11. Coach

- a. Minimum age of 30
- b. 4th Dan or higher

- c. Actively coached for more than 10 years in tournaments and produced more than 5 champions in championships with history and general recognition
- d. Best demonstrates responsibility, integrity, and excellence in martial arts coaching
- e. Outstanding achievement in coaching that inspires athletes
- f. Dedication to facilitating the advancement of athletic competition in the martial arts
- g. The nominees are required to meet at least the following criteria:
 - i. Continuous training and coaching martial arts students at black/advanced belt levels
 - ii. Distinct martial arts philosophy and upholds high ethical standards
 - iii. Demonstrates concern for all-around development of athletes and instills guidelines reflecting responsible conduct beyond the competitive arena
 - iv. Continuously applies and improves relevant training theory and coaching techniques
 - v. Demonstrates respect for officials, athletes and parents and teaches a philosophy of sportsmanship
 - vi. Demonstrates a leadership role in competitions, tournament committees, and/or athletic organizations

12. Referee

- a. Minimum age of 30
- b. 4th Dan or higher
- c. Continuously active as referee for more than 10 years in championships with history and general recognition
- d. Best demonstrates responsibility, integrity, and excellence in refereeing martial arts events
- e. Outstanding achievement and inspiration of athletes
- f. Dedicated to facilitating the advancement of competitive sport martial arts
- g. The nominees are required to meet at least the following criteria:
 - i. Continuous training and refereeing in martial arts
 - ii. Distinct martial arts philosophy and upholds high ethical standards
 - iii. Demonstrates concern for all-around development of athletes and instills guidelines reflecting responsible conduct beyond the competitive arena
 - iv. Continuously applies and improves relevant training theory and referee techniques
 - v. Demonstrates respect for officials, athletes, and parents and teaches a philosophy of sportsmanship
 - vi. Demonstrates a leadership role with utmost fairness in competitions, tournament committees, and/or athletic organizations

13. Martial Arts Promoter

- a. Minimum age of 30
- b. Continuously active for more than 10 year at time of nomination
- c. Martial Arts rank is not required, however, martial arts rank will take precedence in selection
- d. Induction recognizes the individual who has displayed outstanding merit and achieved effective results in promoting and innovating the integrity of martial arts by developing and organizing events such as championships, exhibitions, festivals, conventions, seminars, and the business aspects of martial arts

14. Martial Arts Performer

- a. Minimum age 30
- b. 4th Dan or higher
- c. Continuously active for more than 10 years at time of nomination
- d. Induction recognizes the individual who has performed his/her martial arts skills for the public such as playing a part in a movie, public demonstration at martial arts events, or otherwise performed for the public
- e. Created a higher level of performance skills and improved martial arts performance as a

- performing art. His/her performance has influenced the public regarding martial arts skills and has promoted the virtues of martial arts culture
- f. Motivating martial artists to perfect their skills and creating incentive for the public to study martial arts

15. Martial Arts Spirit

- a. Martial Arts rank is not required, however, martial arts rank will take precedence in selection
- b. Induction recognizes individuals who have exhibited martial arts spirit, its tenets, and martial arts culture at an **extraordinary** level throughout their lives and influenced others in a most positive way

16. Martial Arts Sponsor

- a. Martial Arts rank is not required, however, martial arts rank will take precedence in selection
- b. Induction recognizes individuals or organizations that have displayed **extraordinary** support of and achieved effective results in promoting martial arts through dedicated and consistent sponsorship of athletes, events, and organizations that foster the advancement of martial arts throughout their regions, nations, or the world.

- a. Open to ages 17 and under
- b. Outstanding Competition, Academic Excellence, Leadership, Community Service, Courtesy and Respect
- c. Induction Hall recognizes individuals who have exhibited martial arts spirit, its tenets, and martial arts culture to others throughout their lives and influenced others in a most positive way.
- d. Requires recommendation letters from
 - i. school teacher
